

## Blackpool Cricket Club Emergency Procedures

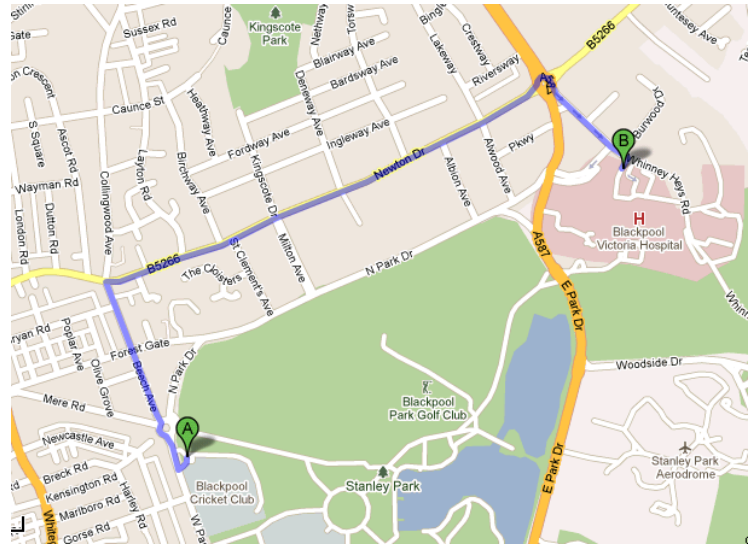
In the event of an accident or emergency the nearest A&E Unit is

### Dealing with an incident or accident

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Ask yourself 'is there danger of further injuries?'
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services on 999.
- For non-emergency injuries, the telephone number for NHS Advice is 111.
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency services.
- Contact the injured person's parent, carer or guardian.
- Complete an Accident Report Form.
